About The Mentorship

What topics would be covered in the mentorship program?

Any topic the mentor and mentee thinks would be relevant. We hope that this happens organically where students ask questions. Common questions could be about applications for internships and jobs. They could also be about navigating day to day living. The mentor answers whatever they feel comfortable with.

Is this an August to May school-year-long commitment?

We suggest a 2-hour commitment over the academic year from August to May. Essentially one hour per semester. But again, this can be longer if the mentor would like to offer more of their time.

Would the mentors and mentees attend any events together?

Again, depending on level of comfort, the mentor could come to some of the virtual events or pizza events for students, but not required.
